

ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF
THE VILLAGE OF CLARKS GROVE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
(PLATTED) (UNPLATTED) LAND

Introduced by Galvin De Roos

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Clarks Grove, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Clarks Grove, Minnesota:

Commencing at a point on the South line of the South one-half of the Northwest Quarter of Section Thirty-five, Township One Hundred Four North, Range Twenty-one West of the 5th P.M. where the Freeborn County Highway No. Twenty-four right-of-way intersects with said line; thence North Twenty-five rods; thence East Thirty-two rods; thence South Twenty-five rods; thence West Thirty-two rods to the point of beginning.

The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 5 acres, more or less.

THE VILLAGE OF CLARKS GROVE DOES ORDAIN:

Sec. 1. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Clarks Grove and to the territory affected; that the territory described herein abute upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

Sec. 2. That the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of Clarks Grove as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copies thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State and from and after its passage and publication.
