WHEREAS, the United States of America is a leading proponent of this desire for peace; and

WHEREAS, this supreme aim requires a high degree of moral rectitude and justice in social and administrative activities, and complete freedom from prejudice in dealing with people of different race, class, creed and color; and

WHEREAS, the Baha'is of the State of Minnesota are joining in the national observance of World Peace Day;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, September 16, 1962, as
