

A PROCLAMATION FOR "PROTECTION WEEK"


- WHEREAS, the National Association of Insurance Agents has prepared a campaign to improve the Insurance Protection Plans of the American people, and

- WHEREAS, the citizens of our state are being asked to take advantage of these services as a protection against financial loss through unfortunate mishap,



"PROTECTION WEEK"


in Minnesota, and I urge our citizens to participate therein by having a "check-up" of their individual protection plans during this period.
