MONDALE, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 8.06, Minnesota Statutes, 1961, have constituted and appointed JOSEPH H. DINGLE, of Rochester, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General, for the purpose of representing the State in the case of State Veterinary Examining Board v. Conrad Berglund, and to advise the Board in connection with the application of Gerald Schwartz to take the Minnesota Veterinary Medicine examination. He shall be compensated on a reasonable fee basis, which shall include all clerical and other necessary office expenses incurred by counsel, together with necessary travel expenses, said compensation to be paid from the funds of the State Veterinary Examining Board upon verified claims therefor presented to said Board by the appointee. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General and until the matters hereinbefore mentioned are completed.




