TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCKINLEY, MINNESOTA.

Gentlemen:-

We, the undersigned, Lake Superior Consolidated Iron Mines, a New Jersey corporation, and the Duluth & Iron Range Rail Road Company, a Minnesota corporation, do hereby petition the Village Council of the Village of McKinley to have the lands hereinafter described annexed to and become a part of and an addition to said Village and that the boundaries of said Village be extended so as to include said lands, which are situated in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota, abutting upon the Village of McKinley, and are described as follows, to-wit: the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eight (8) and the North half of the Southwest quarter ( $N\frac{1}{2}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seventeen (17), all in Township Fifty-eight (58) North of Range Sixteen (16) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

Lake Superior Consolidated Iron Mines is the owner in fee of the lands above described in Section Eight (8) and is the only person or corporation owning or having any interest therein, excepting only the rights of The Duluth & Iron Range Rail Road Company in its railroad right of way across the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Eight (8).

The Duluth & Iron Range Rail Road Company is the owner in fee of the lands above described in Section Seventeen (17) and is the only person or corporation owning or having any interest therein, excepting only the interest of the Village of McKinley in a part thereof under an indenture made by and between The Duluth & Iron Range Rail Road Company and the Village of McKinley under date of November 13, 1915, leasing a part of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Seventeen (17), containing .278 acres, more or less, unto the Village for five (5) years from said date, for the maintenance of a pumping station thereon, subject to all the provisions of said indenture.

The above named petitioners hereby petition and request the

Village Council of the Village of McKinley that a proper ordinance of said Village be duly adopted, passed and published and that such further proceedings be had and performed as to cause said lands to be duly annexed to, become a part of and include within the boundaries of said Village, all in accordance with the statutes in such case made and provided.

VILLAGE ORDINANCE NO. 27

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Lands Therein Described to the Village of McKinley, St. Louis County, Minnesota. The Village Council of the Village of McKinley, St. Louis County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Lake Superior Consolidated Iron Mines, a New Jersey corporation, and the Duluth & Iron Range Rail Road Company, a Minnesota corporation, being the sole owners of those tracts, pieces or parcels of land lying and being in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota, and described as follows, to-wit: the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (SE 1/4 of NW 1/4) and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NE 1/4 of SW 1/4) of Section Eight (8) and the North half of the Southwest quarter (N 1/2 of SW 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17), all in Township Fifty-eight (58) North of Range Sixteen (16) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, said lands abutting upon the Village of McKinley, having petitioned the Village Council of the Village of McKinley to have said lands included within the corporate limits of said Village and annexed to said Village:

It is Hereby Ordained, Enacted and Declared, that said tracts, pieces or parcels of land above described be, and the same hereby are, annexed to the said Village of McKinley, and as an addition to said Village and the boundaries and corporate limits of said Village are hereby extended so as to include said lands, and said lands shall be, and hereby do, become a part of said village as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

Section 2. The Village Clerk of the Village of McKinley shall cause a certified copy of this ordinance to be recorded and filed in the office of the County Auditor of St. Louis County, and with the Secretary of State of Minnesota.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS THEREIN DESCRIBED TO THE  
VILLAGE OF MCKINLEY, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

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The Village Council of the Village of McKinley, St. Louis County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1.
