We, Joseph L. Donovan, Secretary of State; Oscar R. Knutson, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court; Walter F. Rogosheske, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court; John W. Graff, Judge of the District Court, Second Judicial District; Dana Nicholson, Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, the legally constituted and acting State Canvassing Board, as required by law, opened and canvassed on September 25, 1962, the certified copies of the statements made by the County Canvassing Boards of the votes cast at the September 11, 1962, Primary Election, and we prepared therefrom a statement of the whole number of votes cast at said Primary Election for the several State officers and for Representatives in Congress, Senators and Representatives in the State Legislature, Associate Justices of the Supreme Court, and Judges of District Court, and we have specified the names of the persons receiving such votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast, which statement is as follows. 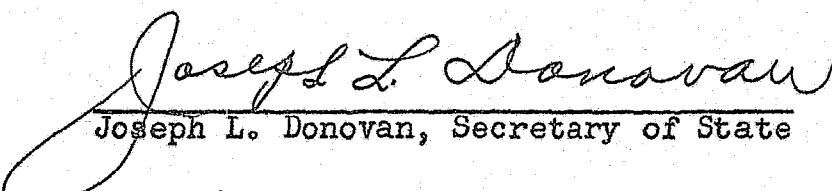

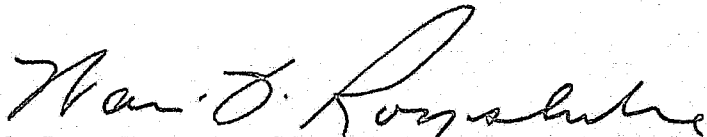

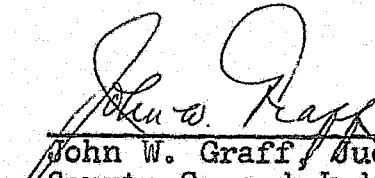
