ORDINANCE NO. 50

VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, KANDIYOHI COUNTY, MINNESOTA  
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO  
THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON  
CERTAIN LANDS WHICH ABOUT  
THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON  
LOCATED IN SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 121, RANGE 34, KANDIYOHI COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE  
VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, KANDIYOHI COUNTY, MINNESOTA,  
ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That said lands to be annexed about the Village of New London, are not included in any other municipality, are unplatted and do not exceed 200 acres in extent, are owned by a single owner who has petitioned to have such lands included within the Village of New London.

Section 2. That the annexation of said lands to the Village of New London is in the best interest of the Village of New London and of the lands to be annexed.

Section 3. That said lands are hereby declared to be and are annexed to the Village of New London, said lands being particularly described as follows:

The North Six Hundred Sixty (660) feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Fifteen (15), Twp. One Hundred Twenty-one (121), Range Thirty-four (34), Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section Fifteen (15), Township One Hundred Twenty-one (121), Range Thirty-five (35) except part North and East of Center line of Trunk Highway No. 71.

Section 4. That the Village Clerk shall publish this ordinance as required by law and deliver a copy of this ordinance to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, all as provided in Laws of Minnesota 1959, c. 686, 4 (MSA 414.03 (2)), as amended Laws 1961, c. 645, 3.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication, as provided by law.

Richardson, being duly sworn, on oath says: that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher of the newspaper known as THE NEW LONDON TIMES and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the NOTICE hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the Village of New London, in the County of Kandiyohi, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the Village from which it purports to be issued as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and equipped with the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; and the presswork on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve has been done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; and that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper; that a copy of said newspaper is filed with the State Historical Society.
