A PROCLAMATION FOR "NATIONAL TERMINAL LIVESTOCK MARKET MONTH"

- WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota is an important livestock producing State with a substantial part of the total farmer income derived from the marketing of livestock; and
- WHEREAS, the year 1962 marks the centennial of the founding of the system of Land Grant Universities and Colleges in the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS, the University of Minnesota was founded in the year 1851 for the purpose, among others, of promoting the agriculture of the State, including the production and marketing of livestock; and
- WHEREAS, the year 1962 also marks the diamond anniversary of the South St. Paul livestock market; and
- WHEREAS, the Land Grant Universities and Colleges generally and the University of Minnesota in particular by their research, educational and extension programs have contributed greatly to the prosperity and well-being of the farmers, ranchers, feeders, marketing agencies, processors, distributors and consumers of livestock, meat and other livestock and meat food products; and
- WHEREAS, the terminal livestock market of South St. Paul, Minnesota for many years has provided livestock producers of this State a conveniently located, efficiently operated, effectively regulated, open, competitive market for the sale of their livestock and the assurance of fair trade practices, competent selling services and prompt and secured payment for all livestock sold:
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October 1962 as

NATIONAL TERMINAL LIVESTOCK MARKET MONTH

and do hereby urge all citizens and institutions of this State serving or related to the livestock industry to participate actively in the promotion and the celebration of this event.
