A PROCLAMATION FOR "PULASKI DAY"

WHEREAS, General Pulaski served the cause of American freedom well during the War for Independence and left America a rich heritage which every freedom-loving citizen appreciates; and,

WHEREAS, General Pulaski's memory is carried forward by the many Americans of Polish descent, including those residing in Minnesota, who are rightfully proud of the great contribution made to the upbuilding of our State and Nation made by distinguished citizens of Polish ancestry; and,

WHEREAS, it is fitting that not only General Pulaski but the contributions of Americans of Polish descent be honored on October 11, 1962;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby designate October 11, 1962 as

"PULASKI DAY"

in Minnesota and urge all our citizens to pay tribute to the memory of this great leader.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol on this second day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two and of our State the one hundred fifth.
