A PROCLAMATION FOR "ORAL POLIO VACCINATION DAYS"

WHEREAS, the Ramsey and Hennepin County Medical Societies are providing the Oral Polio Vaccination for our people of the Twin Cities and surrounding communities; and,

WHEREAS, due to the efforts of our medical societies, polio can be conquered not only in the Great State of Minnesota, but in the entire world through the use of polio vaccine; and,

WHEREAS, everyone in this area should take advantage of the facilities offered by these organizations in the prevention of polio:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the days of November 10-11, 1962, and January 12-13, 1963, as

ORAL POLIO VACCINATION DAYS

and urge all of our citizens to use the facilities provided by these organizations in the prevention of polio. I Burther urge that during the daylight hours, all motorists in the vaccination areas keep their lights on as a dual reminder to drive safely and to take their families to receive their oral vaccine.
