

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY  
OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED  
LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated September 11, 1962, requesting  
annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented  
to the Common Council on the 8th day of October, 1962; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described  
in the petition and bounded as described is one-half acre of unplatted  
land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated  
city; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city  
limits at the western boundary thereof;

The Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota do ordain as  
follows:

Section 1. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation  
will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected;  
(2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is  
urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is  
now included within the limits of any city.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city  
are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows  
and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as  
effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof;

Beginning at a point 224.7 feet north of the  
southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of  
the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Five  
(5), Township One Hundred Eleven (111) north  
of Range Forty-one (41) West; thence north  
105.3 feet, thence at right angles to last  
line west 173 feet, thence at right angles  
to last line south 188.2 feet to the Railroad  
right of way, thence northeast along said  
Railroad right of way to the point of beginning.  
(Containing one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) acre, more or less.)

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file  
certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission,  
the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.
