

Resolution by the City Council of the City of Ortonville in the Counties of Big Stone and Lac Qui Parle, to adopt and become subject to the provisions of Chapter 303 of the General Laws of 1913, relative to the issuance of bonds:

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Ortonville, in the Counties of Big Stone and Lac Qui Parle, that the provisions of Chapter 303 of the General Laws of 1913, "being an act granting additional powers to cities having a population of 20,000 or less, to issue its bonds for certain purposes therein specified," be and the same hereby are in all respects adopted by said City of Ortonville, and the said City shall in all things become subject to and in all things avail itself of the provisions of said act and all the rights and authorities therein granted, and the said act and all its provisions are hereby adopted as a part of the charter or law covering said City, pursuant to the provisions of said act, and the Clerk of said City is hereby authorized and directed to file with the Secretary of State a copy of this resolution together with the record as provided by Section Four of said Chapter 303 of the laws of 1913.
