
Re: Village of Cokato



ORDINANCE

An ordinance providing for annexation of certain land abutting the village upon petition of a majority of the owners thereof.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF OKATE, MINNESOTA, ORDINANCE:

Section 1.

That pursuant to a petition by a majority, in numbers, of the owners of certain property comprising less than two hundred (200) acres, described as follows:

The South 25 rods of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 119, Range 26, but excluding from the above described area that portion of said area described as follows:

Commencing at the Section line 25 rods North from the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, and 797 feet West, as a point of beginning; thence South 52 feet; thence West five rods; thence North 52 feet; thence East five rods, to beginning, all in Section 23, Township 119, Range 26, all lines to run parallel with the government survey lines.

The Village Council has unanimously determined that it is to the best interest of the village and to the best interest of the property to be annexed that it be annexed.

Section 2.

The tract hereinbefore described is, by this ordinance, declared to be annexed to the village of Okate.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of a copy of this ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the County Auditor of Wright County, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
