

ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF ROSEAU, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Roseau, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described land, situated, lying and being in the County of Roseau, and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

A tract of land in the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter (SE¹/₄NE¹/₄) of Section 23, Township 162 North, of Range 40 West, described as follows: commencing at the Northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed by these grantors to Walter S. Bell, thence Westerly along the Southern Boundary of Great Northern Railway right of way a distance of two hundred eight feet (208'); thence due South a distance of three hundred twelve feet (312'); thence in an Easterly direction and parallel with the Southern boundary of said railroad right of way to the Westerly boundary of Minnesota Trunk Highway 89 right of way; thence along said Westerly side of said highway right of way to the South^{west} corner of said tract previously conveyed to Walter S. Bell; thence along said boundary of said tract in a Westerly direction to the Southwest corner of said tract conveyed to Walter S. Bell; thence in a Northerly direction along said Westerly Boundary of said tract to the point of commencement, containing two acres more or less, being a part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE¹/₄NE¹/₄) of Section 23, Township 162, of Range 40 West.

Also -

A tract of land in the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter (SE¹/₄NE¹/₄) of Section 23, Township 162^{North} of Range 40 West, described as follows: Commencing at a point of intersection of the West boundary line of the right of way of Minnesota State Highway 89 (hereinafter referred to as the Highway right of way) with the South boundary of the right of way of the Great Northern Railway (hereinafter referred to as the railroad right of way); thence Southerly along said highway right of way 208.0 feet; thence West 208.0 feet; thence due North to the South boundary of said railroad right of way and thence in an Easterly direction along said South boundary of said railroad right of way to the point of beginning, being a part of the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄, Section 23, Township 162 North, of Range 40 West, containing 1.0 acres more or less. This tract of land hereinafter referred to in part (2) as the Walter Bell land,

abutting upon the incorporated Village of Roseau, Minnesota, be and the same hereby is annexed to said Village, to become a part of said Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance is passed pursuant to a petition signed by all the owners of the above described real estate.

Section 3. That said real estate is so conditioned as to be subject to municipal government, and that annexation thereof will be for the best interests of said Village and said real estate.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, and filing a copy thereof with the Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of said State of Minnesota.
