WHEREAS, it is fitting that during the Holiday season, which is devoted to the religious concept of good will to men, the basic attitude of patience and understanding to be extended to our conduct as drivers, as well as awareness of our moral responsibility to soberly discharge our obligation to ourselves, our families and our neighbors in our daily travel and activities; and,


WHEREAS, the Minnesota Safety Council is conducting a state-wide program to reduce the annual Holiday season accident toll, and is placing particular emphasis on the need for enthusiastic participation; and,


WHEREAS, the Minnesota Safety Council's "Religious Leaders for Safety" committee has asked all religious and civic leaders to join a state-wide effort to prevent tragic mishaps in our daily assignments and routine;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate the period of time between December 1, 1962, and January 2, 1963, as

" SAFE CONDUCT DURING THE HOLIDAYS "
