Dear Governor Andersen:

This is to correct some inadvertent mistakes in my letter to your office dated the 15th, instant, relating to my retirement.

On examination of the constitutional provisions relating to the terms of state officers (Article 7, Section 9), it would appear that the term of a District Judge probably commences on the first Monday in January of the year and does not conform to the calendar year. My assumption that that my successor would assume office on January 1st is probably in error, and that he will assume office on Monday, January the 7th, 1963.

So that there may be continuity in the office, I make correction in my application in letter to you of November 15, 1962, to commence my retirement effective as of the 6th January 6, 1963, and kindly request that you direct my retirement by written order pursuant to Section 689.102, Minnesota Statutes.
