

ORDINANCE NO. 1765

AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of Rochester, Minnesota, Certain Platted Land Known as 24th Street, Northeast, in Christensen-Sehl Subdivision, Olmsted County, Minnesota.

The Common Council of the City of Rochester do ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, signed by all the owners of all land described therein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land to the City of Rochester. The land described in said petition for annexation is located in Olmsted County, Minnesota, and is described as follows:

The public street known as 24th Street Northeast, in the Christensen-Sehl Subdivision, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the west line of section 24, township 107 north, range 14 west, said point being 253.7 feet north of the southwest corner of said section as measured along the west line thereof; thence due east 91.25 feet; thence south 59° east a distance of 400 feet; thence south 20° 37' east a distance of 694.1 feet to the west right-of-way line of Trunk Highway No. 63; thence southerly and westerly along said right-of-way line to the most easterly corner of lot 10, Christensen-Sehl Subdivision; thence northerly, westerly and southerly along the front lot lines of lots 1 to 10 inclusive of said subdivision as platted, to the west line of said section 24; thence northerly along said west section line to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The Common Council of the City of Rochester does hereby determine that the lands described in Section 1 abut upon the present territorial limits of the City of Rochester, are so conditioned as to be properly subjected to Municipal Government, and the annexation of said lands will be in the best interests of the City of Rochester and of the lands affected.

Section 3. Therefore, the lands described in Section 1 above are hereby annexed, added to and made a part of the City of Rochester, Minnesota, as effectual as if they had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its official publication and from and after the filing of a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State.
