An Ordinance Changing the Village Election Date.

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, Section 205.07 authorizes the council to designate the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as the regular village election date,

AND WHEREAS, the council believes that this change in election date should be made in this village for the reasons that such change will tend to encourage greater voter participation in local matters and will eliminate the additional expense of village elections in the years when national or state elections are held,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MAHTOMEDI DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Commencing with the 1963 village election, the regular village election of the Village of Mahtomedi shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
