

ORDER. The petition of more than eight (8) legal voters, who own real estate or occupy real estate under an agreement or franchise lease of the United States, as aforesaid, within the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the said project, in said petition to be laid out, has been filed with the Court and duly recorded to us for our action thereon:

For, therefore, the Supervisors of the Town Board of the Town of Stuts, St. Louis County, Minnesota, hereby make its order describing, as nearly as practicable, the proposed road sought to be established as follows:

Commencing at the one-quarter corner (1) between sections sixteen (16) and seventeen (17), Township Fifty-eight (58), Range twenty-one (21); thence running due south on the section line between sections sixteen (16) and seventeen (17); twenty (20) and twenty-one (21); twenty-eight (28) and twenty-nine (29) to the Peter and Simpson road, all being in Township Fifty-eight (58), Range twenty-one (21), and thence terminating.

The Supervisors of the Town Board of the Town of Stuts also hereby make its order describing the several tracts of land through which it is to pass, and the names of the owners thereof, as nearly as we can determine the same, are as follows, to-wit:
