I hereby certify that the following is a true and correct excerpt of minutes of the duly called meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Annandale, held on the *1st* day of *October*, 1962.

RESOLUTION

Councilman Hawkinson introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED, That at the next village election the Optional Plan "A" of M.S.A. 412.541 which provides for the appointment of a village clerk, treasurer and assessor, and the election of an additional trustee, shall be submitted to the voters in the following form:

"Shall Optional Plan "A", modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor be adopted for the government of the village?"

Councilman Tritabaugh seconded the resolution, and on being put to vote, the following members voted in favor thereof: Carlton Magnuson, Harvey W. Hawkinson, Milburn Tritabaugh, Kenneth Peterson, and Robert B. Mackereth.

The following voted against: None

The resolution was duly declared adopted by the mayor.

That following the adoption of said resolution, Optional Plan "A" was submitted to the voters on November 5th, 1962, all in accordance with the election ballot marked "Exhibit A" and hereto attached. That following the closing of the polls of said election on November 6th, 1962, the ballots were duly counted and showed a vote of 233 for the Optional Plan "A", and 104 votes against it. Thereupon, Optional Plan "A" was duly declared adopted.
