ORDINANCE NUMBER 17.

An Ordinance Detaching Certain Real Estate Used Solely For Agricultural Purposes From the Village of Dumont .

Whereas, the territory hereinafter described is and since its first occupation has been occupied and used solely for agricultural purposes and is within the corporate limits of the Village of Dumont, in Traverse County, Minnesota, and a petition duly signed by thirty of the legal voters of said village, including all the owners of the land hereinafter described, to the village council of such village, praying that an election should be held in such village for the purpose of determining by a vote of the people of such village, whether or not the territory hereinafter described should be taken out of the said village which is a municipal corporation and detached therefrom, was heretofore duly filed with said council, whereupon said council duly approved such petition and caused a copy thereof, with a notice attached, fixing a time and place within the corporate limits of such village for holding such election, to-wit: the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1916, in the Village Hall in said village, to be posted in three public places within said village, one at the

S.W. corner of Main Street  
one at the Post Office

and one at the G. Doll Bldg. on lot 14 Blk 4, all of which notices were posted on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Feb., 1916, not less than twenty days nor more than thirty days before said proposed election, and there having been no qualified newspaper published within said village, no published notice of such election was given. And Whereas, said election was duly held in pursuance of said notice, in the same manner in all respects as is provided for holding general village elections and the ballots used had thereon the words "for detaching" and "against detaching" with a space following each such combination of words within which each voter voting thereat might designate his choice in such election, and a majority of the ballots cast at said election having been for detaching,

The Village Council Of Dumont Do Ordain as Follows:

SECTION 1 That the following described territory be and the same hereby is detached from and taken out of the corporate limits of said village of Dumont, viz:

The South Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 126, Range 46, less the right-of-way of the C. M. & St. Paul Ry.

The Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 22 and the West Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 22, Township 126, Range 46.

The West Half of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 15, and the West Half of the East Half of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 15, Township 126, Range 46.

SECTION 2 The Village Recorder is hereby instructed and required to forthwith certify a copy of this ordinance and file the same with the Secretary of State and is further required to certify a copy thereof and file the same for record with the Registrar of Deeds of Traverse County, Minnesota, wherein said village is located.
