KNOW ALL MEN THAT THESE PRESENTS HEREBY CERTIFY, That the foregoing draft of Amendment as proposed to the Charter of the City of St Paul, in the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota, as returned to the Chief Magistrate of said City of St Paul, to-wit, its Mayor, Winn Powers, on the application of five per cent. of the legal voters of said City by written petition to the Board of Freeholders appointed by the Judges of the District Court in the Second Judicial District of said State under and pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Minnesota, was submitted to the qualified voters of said City of St Paul at the General City Election held in said City on the 2nd day of May, 1916, at which said election there were cast in favor of said Amendment, 21,951 votes out of a total vote of 30,921 cast at said election, and at said election said Amendment did receive the votes of more than three-fifths of the qualified voters voting at said election in said city in favor of the adoption and ratification thereof, and said Amendment did receive more than three-fifths of the total vote cast for any purpose at said election, in favor of its adoption and ratification, and that all of the votes so cast by the qualified voters and electors at said election held on the 2nd day of May, 1916 upon the question of the adoption and ratification of said Amendment were duly returned and canvassed by the properly and duly authorized and official Canvassing Board in and for said City, and that said Canvassing Board, after such canvass did duly declare said Amendment to have been duly ratified and adopted by the electors of said city, and it is hereby declared and certified that said Amendment to said Charter was duly and properly ratified and adopted by the qualified voters and electors of said City at said election.

C. F. No. 10484—By Winn Powers—
Whereas the Council of the City of St. Paul has duly canvassed the returns of the votes cast at the General City Election held in the City of St. Paul, Minnesota, on the 2nd day of May, 1916, upon the ratification or rejection of an amendment to the City Charter, Section 223, submitted to the electors of said City for ratification or rejection; and
Whereas, it appears from said returns and the canvass thereof that 21,951 electors voted in favor of the ratification of said Amendment, and that 7,264 electors voted against the ratification and approval and that said Amendment was ratified by the necessary three-fifths vote of all the electors voting thereon; therefore be it
Resolved that said Amendment to the City Charter Section No. 223 is hereby declared to have been ratified and adopted by the electors of said City as required by the Charter and Laws of the City of St. Paul.
