

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE TERRITORY OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS, MINNESOTA, ADDITIONAL TERRITORY, BY SECTION

THE VILLAGE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS, DATED FEBRUARY

Section 15-12. Village Boundary Extended. Pursuant to a petition duly signed by the owner of the land in Benton County described as follows:

A tract of land lying in and being a part of the Northwest 1/4 of Northwest 1/4 of Section 23, Town 36 North, Range 21 West described as follows: Commencing at Northwest corner of Section 23, Town 36 North, Range 21 West; thence South on east line of said Section 23, 733 feet; thence S 55°53' E a distance of 203 feet; thence North parallel to said east line of Section 23 a distance of 32 feet to point of beginning; thence S 55°54' E a distance of 286 feet; thence South 423.73 feet; thence S 57°19' W a distance of 289.72 feet; thence N 45°08' W a distance of 122.10 feet; thence North 420.96 feet to point of beginning, said tract containing 4.3 acres more or less, and subject to any and all encumbrances of record and plotted as BLADEN'S 4TH ADDITION.

The territorial limits of the Village are hereby extended to include such land within its limits, which shall hereafter be governed as other territory of the village is governed.

Section 15-20. Copying to be filed. The Village Clerk shall forward a certificate of this ordinance to the Secretary of State and to the County Auditor for Benton County, Minnesota.

Section 15-21. Effect. Such land shall be annexed upon the filing of the certified copies hereof with the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.
