LEGAL NOTICE

ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1962  
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAYNESVILLE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Paynesville, Minn. by the sole owner of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Paynesville, Minnesota:

All that part of the East Forty-one (E 41) acres of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17) in Township One Hundred Twenty-two (122) of Range Thirty-two (32), Lying and being situate Northerly of the North Right of Way line of State Trunk Highway No. 55 as said Highway is now located and established over and across said premises.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is 6.40 acres more or less.

Section three. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section four. Therefore, The Village of Paynesville, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property herein before described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of Paynesville, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section five. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.

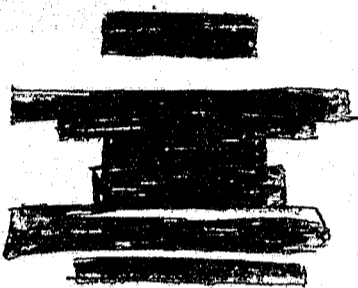
