

ORDINANCE NUMBER 37

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MEYER, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN ~~EXCLUDED LAND~~ ~~250~~ ~~ACRES~~ ~~LAND~~.

Whereas, a certain petition dated December 10, 1962 requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the Council on the 11th day of March, 1963,

And Whereas, it appears that said petition is proper,

The Council of the Village of Meyer, Carver County, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the Village of Meyer are hereby extended to include the following described premises lying and being in the County of Carver and State of Minnesota and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 1, Block 1, Navaho Heights, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Carver County, Minnesota.

Lot 1, Block 2, Navaho Heights, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Carver County, Minnesota.

Lots 2 and 3, Block 2, Navaho Heights, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Carver County, Minnesota.

Lots 4 and 5, Block 2, Navaho Heights, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Carver County, Minnesota.

Lot 6, Block 2, Navaho Heights, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Carver County, Minnesota.

Lot 1, Block 3, Navaho Heights, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Carver County, Minnesota.

Lots 2, Block 3, Navaho Heights, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Carver County, Minnesota.

Lots 3 and 4, Block 3, Navaho Heights, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Carver County, Minnesota.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the Commission of Municipalities, The Carver County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Section 4. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3.
