O R D E R

The Village of Deephaven has, by resolution of the Village Council at a regular meeting held on August 5, 1959, petitioned for the annexation of certain property hereinafter described, and the Village of Minnetonka has concurrently, by resolution of the Village Council at a regular meeting held on September 24, 1959, petitioned to detach the same territory, pursuant to Chapter 686, Minnesota Laws 1959, Section 6(2).

The territory involved consists of:


Lot 16, Auditor's Subdivision No. 299, Hennepin County, Minnesota, according to the recorded plat thereof.

All of the territory involved is <sup>owned</sup> by Eberhardt Company, Lake Office, Wayzata, Minnesota, who has petitioned for the simultaneous detachment from the Village of Minnetonka and annexation to the Village of Deephaven.

All of the requirements of the statute having been met,


