WHEREAS, it is prudent and even vital that we of this generation design a program of protection, perpetuation and wise use not only for ourselves, but for the generations to come, by the adoption of the best programs and the solid understanding and support of all Hinnesota citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate the week of April 28 to May 4 as

"1963 CONSERVATION WEEK"

and Friday, May 3, as

"ARBOR DAY"

and earnestly request that all citizens join in the program to plant trees on Arbor Day and actively promote and urge the adoption of all conservation plans which will enhance the values and wise uses pfour lands, waters and other natural resources.
