"NINETEEN CENTH APRILS COMMEMORATION WEEKEND"

AND WHEREAS, the men, women and children who by unparalleled sacrifice, met death on that weekend symbolize the indomitable spirit of liberty which throughout history has ultimately triumphed against the forces of tyranny; and

AND WHEREAS, the indomitable spirit demonstrated on this historic occasion will forever be an inspiration to oppressed peoples everywhere, and should always be commemorated by freedom loving people throughout the world;

NOW, KARL F. HOLVAG, I, Karl F. Holvag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the weekend of April 19 - 21, 1963, as

"NINETEEN CENTH APRILS COMMEMORATION WEEKEND"

in the State of Minnesota, and do urge our citizens to draw renewed spirit and inspiration from the gallant, significant behavior, sacrifices and acts of these heroic defenseless peoples of Warsaw twenty years ago.
