PROCLAMATION

"Amateur Radio Week"

WHEREAS, amateur radio operators have always demonstrated outstanding cooperation in lending invaluable assistance during periods of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the contributions made by amateur radio operators in a wide variety of fields, such as providing communication between relatives of people stationed overseas; assisting in the prevention and control of forest fires; seeing that communications are kept open in the event of floods, tornadoes and other disasters;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 17 through June 23, 1963 as

"AMATEUR RADIO WEEK"

In Minnesota and urge our citizens to recognize and pay tribute to the many ways in which amateur radio operators contribute to the welfare of the people and greater communication throughout the nation and the world.
