PROCLAMATION FOR THE STATE OF MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, the art of square dancing is unique to our country, its history and an integral and increasingly important part of the recreation of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, in encouraging our citizens' participation in square dancing we shall be able to bring into their lives the pioneer heritage that has become basic to the lives of modern Americans; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Square Dance Federation of Minnesota will assemble during the month of June in the city of St. Paul to be host for the 25th National Square Dance Convention;

AND, WHEREAS, I, Carl F. Johnson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 17 through June 23, 1963 as

SQUARE DANCE WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and pay tribute to the fine work of this group in providing wholesome entertainment and encouraging a sense of appreciation of the customs and traditions of our country.
