PROCLAMATION FOR THE STATE OF MINNESOTA

- WHEREAS, In encouraging our citizens' participation in canoeing we shall help their interest in the pioneer heritage that has become basic to the lives of modern Minnesotans; and
- WHEREAS, The members of the Superior Canoe Association of Minnesota will assemble during the month of June in the city of St. Paul to be host for the 25th Annual Superior Canoe Convention;

Now, therefore, I, Earl W. Kelly, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 17 through June 23, 1963 as
