PROCLAMATION  
NATIONAL RADIO MONTH IN MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, radio, as a mobile medium of communication, is able to provide our citizens with entertainment and information whenever they are, and  
WHEREAS, radio has the ability to bring us on-the-spot coverage of events as they occur, and  
WHEREAS, radio is operated by dedicated men and women who serve our citizens in many ways as well as in diverse places, and  
WHEREAS, this service contributes to the strength of our communities, states and nations.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1963, as
