WHEREAS, the United States Treasury FREEDOM LONG DRIVE is designed to remind and aid every citizen to perform his patriotic duty by investing in his nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Olivaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of May 1, to July 4, 1963, as

FREEDOM BOND DRIVE MONTH

and call upon all Minnesotans to dedicate themselves to the principles of freedom by buying at least one extra savings bond during this period.
