

ORDINANCE NO. 1678

An Ordinance extending the corporate limits of the City of Albert Lea to include certain platted land

Introduced by Councilman Francis Crawford

Sec. 1. Whereas, a petition has been received for the annexation to the City of Albert Lea of the following described property:

Lots 32 through 70 inclusive, less those portions of lots previously annexed to the City of Albert Lea, of Jobs Building Subdivision of part of the NW Section 21, T 102N, Range 21 W, County of Freeborn and all of Railroad Ave and 14th Street lying adjacent to the above described lots

Sec. 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is 42.37 Acres.

Sec. 3. The City Council hereby determines: (1) That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Albert Lea, Minnesota and of the territory effected; (2) That the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to City government.

Sec. 4. The City of Albert Lea hereby declares that the property above described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the City of Albert Lea, Minnesota as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Sec. 5. The above described property is hereby designated as R-2 Heavy Industrial district zoning, and shall be so indicated on the zoning District Map.

Sec. 6. This annexation shall be deemed final and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, County Auditor and the Secretary of State and from and after its passage and publication.
