PROCLAMATION

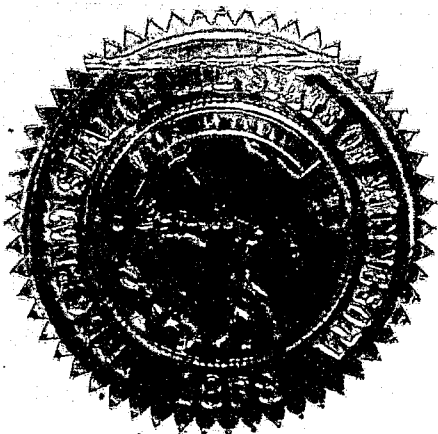
INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MACHINISTS MONTH
