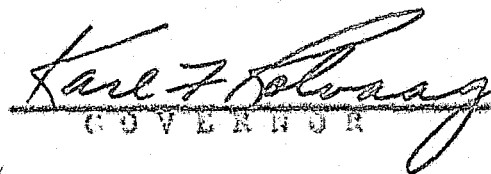
WHEREAS, it is the objective of Government Employees' Month to provide Survival Courses for government employees,

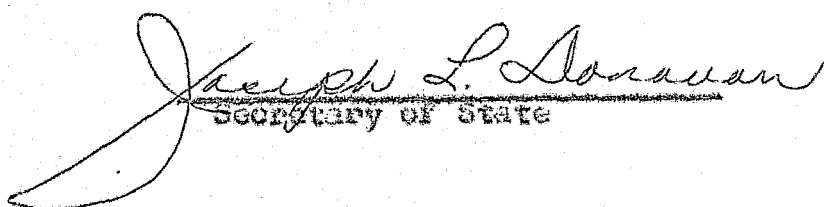
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June 1963, as

GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES' MONTH

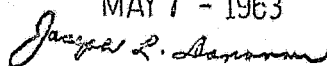
and call upon all elected and appointed officials and employees to participate in this urgently-needed program.
