PROCLAMATION

"SERBIAN DAYS"

- WHEREAS, Minnesota has formed a strong and vigorous society through the assimilation of diverse cultures and national origins; and
- WHEREAS, our heritage and background are an integral part of contemporary customs and interests; and
- WHEREAS, our people of Serbian origins have contributed generously to our now flourishing timber and logging industry, to the iron ore industry from which we have all richly benefited in the past, and in many other fields of endeavor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare July 14 and 15, 1963, as

"SERBIAN DAYS"

in Minnesota and urge that our residents recognize and pay tribute to the outstanding contribution made to our society by our fellow citizens of Serbian heritage.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this third day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and of the State the one hundred sixth.
