You are therefore by these presents, appointed and commissioned Special Judge, to sit from day to day as aforesaid,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said office of special judge, to sit from day to day, together with all the rights, powers and emoluments to the said office belonging, or by law in anywise appertaining, until this commission shall be by me or other lawful authority, superseded or annulled, or expire by force or reason of any law of this State.
