



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WALTER F. MONDALE, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 8.02, do hereby constitute and appoint

JAMES D. MASON


of Saint Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to the Department of Railroad and Warehouse Commission for the period commencing July 2, 1963, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said JAMES D. MASON at the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9,000) Dollars per year, to be paid from the appropriation made for the Department of Railroad and Warehouse Commission.


