HARLEY G. SWENSON

of Saint Paul, Minnesota, as Assistant Attorney General in the Department of the Attorney General for the period commencing July 1, 1963, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said HARLEY G. SWENSON at the sum of Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$13,000) per year, to be paid from the appropriation for the Department of the Attorney General.
