VILLAGE OF NEW BRITTON, AND THE APPROVAL, AMENDMENT AND APPROVAL
OF ORDINANCE NO. 144, DATED SEPTEMBER 1, 1963, SECTION 6.**

STATEMENT

The Village of Arden Hills has, by resolution of the Village Council at a regular meeting held June 14, 1963, partitioned for the detachment of certain property designated as Parcel No. 1, and the Village of New Brighton has concurrently, by resolution of the Village Council at a regular meeting held on June 14, 1963, partitioned to annex the same territory, pursuant to Chapter 404, Minnesota Laws 1963, Sec. 6.

The territory designated as Parcel No. 1 consists of:


All that part of Block 52, Sherwood Hills No. 7 according to the plat thereof on file in the office of the Register of Deeds, lying South and West of the westerly line of Trunk Highway No. 260, commonly referred to as I. M. No. 35W, as described in the Minnesota Highway Department Notice of Line Pending recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Ramsey County in Book 1724 of Ramsey County Records at Page 597;

All of the requirements of the statute having been met,

IT IS ORDERED: That the above described real property be, and is hereby detached from the Village of Arden Hills and annexed to the Village of New Brighton, the same as if it had originally been a part thereof.


