APRIL 16, 1959, CHARTERED, ETC., ET AL.

The Village of Grand Meadow Inn, by resolution at a regular meeting
of the Village Council held on the 16th day of April, 1959, petitioned
for the annexation of certain property adjacent to the village boundary,
unplatted, occupied and used exclusively for agricultural purposes,
hereinafter described, from the Village of Grand Meadow, Minnesota. An
identical petition has been received from all of the owners of the
property affected.

The territory involved consists of:

The West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast
Quarter and the South Half of the Northeast Quarter of
Section Twenty-five (25), in Township One Hundred Three
(103) North of Range Fifteen (15) West; and beginning
at the Northwest corner of the East Half of the North-
west Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty-
Five (25) in Township One Hundred Three (103) North of
Range Fifteen (15) West; thence East Two Hundred feet
(200); thence South parallel with the West line of the
East Half of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast
Quarter a distance of Seven Hundred Thirty feet (730)
more or less to a point Five Hundred Ninety feet (590)
North of the South line of said quarter-quarter; thence
East Two Hundred Forty-four feet (244), more or less, to
the Northwest corner of the tract of land deeded to Ole
E. Nykro by warranty deed recorded in Book "A" of Deeds,
on page 598, in the office of the Register of Deeds,
Kanor County, Minnesota, said Northwest corner being Two
Hundred Twenty-one and one-half feet (221 $\frac{1}{2}$) West of the
East line of said quarter-quarter; thence South along
the West line of said tract Five hundred Ninety feet (590)
to the South line of said quarter-quarter; thence West
Four Hundred Forty-four feet (444) more or less, to the
West line of said East Half of the Northwest Quarter of
the Northeast Quarter aforesaid; thence North along said
West line to the place of beginning, excepting therefrom
all public roads and highways, and further excepting there-
from the North One hundred foot (100) of the above des-
cribed real estate lying adjacent and contiguous to Third
Street of the Village of Grand Meadow, Minnesota, said
North boundary of the described premises for this purpose
being the South right-of-way line of said Third Street of
Grand Meadow, Minnesota.

The property is unclaimed, abandoned and fit exclusively for agricultural purposes. The property is in the possession of the State of Minnesota and is subject to its jurisdiction. The land is not subject to personally partitioned property rights, it is owned in the general form and scope of title information contained in prior deeds, mortgages, contracts, and other title documents and interests, the ownership boundaries being fully disclosed in the previous.

It is ordered that the preceding described real property be, and be hereby, detached from the village of Grand Meadow and set aside.
