SETTING THE DATE FOR VILLAGE ELECTIONS

BE IT RESOLVED: Pursuant to Minn. Stat. 205.07, the Village Board for the Village of Round Lake, Minnesota, hereby ordains that the date for holding the regular annual Village election shall be on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in December of each year.
