ORDINANCE NO. 13

ORDINANCE CHANGING VILLAGE ELECTION DATE

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, Section 205.07 authorized the council to designate the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as the regular village election date,

AND WHEREAS, the council believes that this change in election date should be made in this village,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TURTLE RIVER, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS

Section 1. Commencing with the 1963 village election, the regular village election of the Village of Turtle River shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
