PROCLAMATION

"FOSTER MOTHER WEEK"

WHEREAS, the suggestion of Mrs. Clarence Kruse of Dundas, Minnesota, that a week be set aside in Minnesota to honor the selfless contribution made by foster mothers is a worthy one, and

WHEREAS, foster mothers provide comfort and love to children desperately in need of this assistance without thought of recompense, and

WHEREAS, children are given an opportunity to grow into thoughtful and responsible citizens through the dedication and unselfish generosity of the foster mothers, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Clarence Kruse, herself a foster mother, has aptly and beautifully described the feelings of a foster mother in her poem, "Children in Our House".

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 23 through July 29, 1963, as
