PROCLAMATION

"HIGHWAY WEEK"

WHEREAS, the continued improvement of our State's road and highway systems is necessary for increased safety, the growth of our economy and National Defense, and

WHEREAS, six hundred and seventy-four motorists and pedestrians were killed, and thirty-six thousand, nine hundred and thirty-five were injured last year in motor vehicles accidents in Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, this tremendous loss of lives and crippling injuries can be reduced very substantially through continued emphasis on highway safety and highway improvements, and

WHEREAS, the support of every citizen is essential to the development of a safe, efficient and modern transportation network,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 26 to June 1, 1963, as

"HIGHWAY WEEK"

and ask all public and private organizations, and the general public to join in observance of this occasion. During this period I encourage all Minnesotans to consider and appreciate the value of highway transportation to their own activities.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-ninth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and of the State the one hundred sixth.
