PROCLAMATION

"TEEN-AGE SAFE-DRIVING WEEK"

WHEREAS,

WHEREAS,

safety-consciousness and driving skill are more easily acquired at an early age, and

WHEREAS,

the most acceptable method of engendering safety-consciousness and driving skill in our young people is a continuing program of education and training which stresses a thorough knowledge of and a close adherence to the rules of safety as well as adequate coaching in the proper operation of an automobile, and

WHEREAS,

it is one of the several duties of the State to encourage and promote safety-consciousness and driving skill, especially on the part of the young drivers.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl E. Polkay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do herein proclaim the week of June 9 through June 15, 1963, as

"TEEN-AGE SAFE-DRIVING WEEK"

in Minnesota.
