PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, this great nation and State of Minnesota has welcomed peoples of all nations regardless of race, creed, color, or nationality and given them a freedom never known to any culture or civilization, and

WHEREAS, those of Serbian nationality who came to this state and cherished this freedom, gave to this state their hearts, minds, and hands in developing its great national resources and with their sons and daughters defended the freedom of this state and nation and provided greatly to the state in the fields of education, science and government and other cultural developments, and

WHEREAS,

President Kennedy and I, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, have asked all of the people of this great nation and state to rededicate ourselves to the Idea that all men are free and equal regardless of race, creed, color, or nationality, as expressed by all of the people of the State of Minnesota, including those of Serbian nationality.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvsag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 6th and 7th as,

SERBIAN DAYS

in the State of Minnesota, and congratulate the Serbian people for their love of freedom and equality of all peoples.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twelfth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty three, and of the State, the one hundred sixth.
