WHEREAS, Kentucky, the "Bluegrass State," is noted for its self-reliant people who share with us the building of a mighty nation, and

WHEREAS, Kentucky and Kentuckians, though far away, have become familiar and respected by us through their famous music and fabulous exploits on the nation's frontiers throughout our history, and

WHEREAS, it is apparent that, as integral parts of a great and glorious nation, our peoples share countless traditions, common goals, and aspirations, and are, thereby, truly good neighbors,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvaca, Governor of the State of Minnesota, in honor of and in friendship for this majestic fellow-sovereign state to the South, do hereby proclaim the period June 24 through June 27, 1963, to be

"KENTUCKY NEIGHBOR DAYS"

In Minnesota and I delegate representatives of the Minnesota Junior Chambers of Commerce to make known these greetings to the people of Kentucky and I call upon the people of the State of Minnesota to spiritually join hands in eternal friendship with the citizens of Kentucky in the spirit of our ancestors, in order that we may continue to work together to build a stronger, more perfect Union of States.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed hereunto at the State Capitol this eighteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and of the State the one hundred sixth.
