PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, September 17, 1963 is notable as marking the one hundred seventy-sixth anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, To accord official recognition to this memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic exercise which will form a noteworthy feature of the occasion, seems fitting and proper; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Public Law No. 915, the President of the United States has issued a Proclamation designating September 17 through 23 as CONSTITUTION WEEK;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvacaq, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17-23, 1963 as

"CONSTITUTION WEEK"

in the State of Minnesota and urge all our citizens to pay special attention during that week to our Federal Constitution and the advantages of American citizenship.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twelfth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three, and of the State the one hundred sixth.
